algebra: The standard we are focusing on involves units and conversions. Students will be working on formulating equations for these proportions to solve for various units. Look for worksheets or book work coming home on this topic. There will be a quiz on converting units following our break. A conversion chart, as well as a study guide for converting units will be sent home with your student.

e.l.a.: In ELA this week, students are working on summarizing a text using key details. This week they have a vocabulary quiz as well as their final book summary assessment on their chosen novel.

pre-algebra: The Pre-Algebra standard we are focusing on involves various ways of representing data and analyzing it statistically. Students will be making corrections to their statistical questions quiz. 6th & 7th grade students will also be receiving flash cards for multiplication & division math facts at parent-teacher conferences this week. Students will be logging their minutes of practice with a weekly goal of 60 minutes.

6th & 7th science:

In science this week, we will be finishing up our class discussion on the importance of conserving energy, as well as previewing our next topic of electricity. Our next skill standard will be: "Ask questions about data to determine the factors that affect the strength of electric & magnetic forces."

8th grade science:

In science this week we will be reviewing what we have learned about weather patterns, with the first assessment on Tuesday. The skill standard is: "Collect data to provide evidence for how the motions & complex interactions of air masses results in changes in weather conditions."

social studies:

In social studies this week, we will be catching up on missing assignments.

spanish:

In Spanish this week, we are finishing up identifying cognates, which are Spanish words that look and/or sound like their English counterpart. We also have started looking at the three types of regular Spanish verbs: -er, -ir, and -ar ending verbs and how to conjugate them for sentences.

p.b.l:

In project-based learning this week, we are wrapping up our garden presentations and our unit on the chickens. Students will be voting on what they would like to see as the next project for our PBL class. We will also be discussing what diseases chickens can get and the signs and symptoms to look for as well as the signs of frostbite in chickens as we enter the cold winter months.
