Illness & Mask Policy For In-Person Instruction

1. Parents/Guardians will be required to submit a daily Health Certification Form for each child.
2. Parents/Guardians and staff members must notify school office of a positive COVID result. This will also include close contacts within the household.
3. Students or staff awaiting COVID testing results, regardless of the circumstance, may not attend any in-person learning.
4. A student who presents with symptoms of illness during school will be sent to the Health Office. Parents/Guardians are required to have their symptomatic child(ren) picked up immediately. Symptomatic children should be taken to their primary care physician for further medical evaluation.
5. One or more of the following criteria **MUST** be met before re-entry to school. Documents supporting negative lab results or diagnoses must be submitted for review.

7. The health office will report any COVID diagnoses to the McHenry County Department of Public Health.
8. Students who cannot attend in-person instruction for extended periods of time due to illness or quarantine will receive accommodations to continue to attend school using an electronic platform.
9. Parents/guardians **MUST** contact the school for contactless pick-up of learning materials for remote learning.
10. Students who refuse to wear a mask will receive disciplinary actions which may include student being sent home for the day and possible automatic transfer to a Remote Learning Platform.
11. Masks should include two or more layers of fabric, completely cover nose and mouth, and fit snugly against the sides of your face.
12. **DO NOT** wear masks that have exhalation valves or vents that allow particles to escape.
