I will address individual needs as required by the IEP and keep in communication with the student's special education teachers.	
I will establish consistent daily/weekly office hours to answer questions and meet with parents/students.	
I will communicate clear expectations of deadlines allowing weekly submission of completed assignments by Friday 12:00 p.m. Packets to be picked up (when applicable) will be available by Friday after 12:00 p.m.	

Student's Expectations: It is my responsibility to be a learner and engage in my learning experiences during Virtual Learning Days.
