

## STUDENT WITHDRAWAL FROM SCHOOL

Student withdrawal from school may be classified into three categories: Those who transfer to another school system, either public or private, those who excused from attendance pursuant to SDCL 13-27-1.1 (religious exemption) or 13-27-2 and 13-27-3 (receiving alternative instruction), and those who withdraw from permanent attendance at any school (dropouts).

If a parent or guardian wishes to withdraw a student from school to transfer to another school district the parent or guardian should contact the principal who will instruct him/her as to procedure. When transferring to another school, the parent or guardian should make arrangements with the office to forward records to the proper school.

Students who are residents of the Montrose School District and who have dropped out of school will be permitted to re-enroll. If re-enrollment is at any time other than the beginning of a semester, the student may not receive semester credit for the semester when the student re-enrolled due to the remaining period of time in the semester in which the student re-enrolled.
