## STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

When a child is riding, boarding, or leaving the bus, the bus driver has supervisory authority over the student and may exercise reasonable and necessary physical force necessary for supervisory control over students.

Students shall conduct themselves on the bus, while waiting for the bus and when departing the bus in a manner consistent with the Student Conduct Policy as set forth in Policy JFC.

In cases when a child does not conduct him(her)self properly on a bus, such instances will be brought to the attention of the building principal and transportation supervisor by the bus driver. The building principal will inform the parents immediately of the misconduct.

Students who violate the school bus conduct policy and related school/bus driver rules may have their riding privileges suspended by the principal on a short term or long term basis. In such cases when bus riding privileges are suspended, the parents of the children involved become responsible for seeing that their children get to and from school.
