The Judge Samuel I. and Lora E. Mason Scholarship was established in 2017. Samuel was a 1951 graduate of Fort Scott High School and attended Fort Scott Community College and Pittsburg State University. Samuel's three daughters graduated from Fort Scott High School, Fort Scott Community College and Pittsburg State University. Samuel and Lora have always been involved in the growth and development of the youth from our community.

Guidelines are as follows:

- 1. The applicant must be a current Fort Scott High School senior in good standing.**
- 2. The applicant must be planning to attend Fort Scott Community College.**
- 3. The applicant must complete the formal scholarship application form and submit documentation to the FSHS Counseling office by due date on the application.**
- 4. Fort Scott High School shall serve as custodian of the scholarship award. Amount to be awarded is \$500 (scholarships to be awarded annually).**
- 5. Scholarships shall be awarded at the annual FSHS Senior Awards Assembly.**
- 6. The Mason Family shall select and determine the recipient(s) of the scholarship(s).**
- 7. Recipient(s) selection shall be based on the following:**
 - i. Financial Need**
 - ii. Academics**
 - iii. Extra-curricular Activities**
 - iv. Autobiography**
 - v. Community Involvement**
- 8. Scholarship payment shall be made to the scholarship recipient by Fort Scott High School. Scholarship funds shall be used as the student sees fit to assist with the student's academic career.**
- 9. Scholarship recipient(s) must be enrolled in at least 12 credit hours at Fort Scott Community College.**
- 10. Scholarship recipient(s) must provide proof of enrollment in the form of a schedule to the Fort Scott High School Treasurer by August 1st and a check will be disbursed shortly thereafter.**
