Enrollment for Driver Education—Due April 28

To enroll in the Circle District Driver Education Program a student must meet the following qualifications:

• Students must be **15** years of age by **June I** <u>OR</u>: • Students must have completed their **Freshman year.** • Persons not regularly enrolled in a secondary program (high school) but who are eligible to apply for a motor vehicle operator's license shall be eligible, provided there is space in the class.

To successfully complete the driver education program, the student must:

- 1. Pass each test at 80% or higher.
- 2. Must complete each behind-the-wheel lesson at 80% or higher.

The class will begin **Tuesday, May 30, 2023** at **Circle High School auditorium** from **8:00-11:00** am. The class schedule will be the following 10 days:

May 30 - June 3 (Tuesday - Saturday) June 5- June 9 (Monday - Friday)

Each student will receive a schedule for their driving lessons. Because of the number of students involved, it is impossible to avoid conflicts. Parents are asked to be understanding. The application form above must be completed and returned to Circle High School no later than **Friday, April 28**, **2023**.

Kansas law states that before a student can obtain a **restricted driver's license** they must meet <u>all</u> of the following criteria:

- Minimum age of 15 years old.
- Have successfully completed an approved <u>driver education</u> course
- Must have held instructional permit for at least <u>one</u>
 <u>year</u>.
 Must have completed at least <u>50 hours</u> of adult supervised driving.
- Written **application** of parent/guardian required.

Upon successful completion of this course the student must wait one year after learners permit is obtained to receive a restricted license.

VERY IMPORTANT!

Due to changes in State law, it is HIGHLY recommended that all students planning to enroll in Circle's Summer Driver Education course obtain a farm permit or an instructional permit as early as possible after they turn 14. A student must have an Instructional Permit for at least ONE FULL year before they can receive a restricted driver's license at 15 years of age.

The cost for the Driver Education course is \$150.00 for district residents and students attending Circle High School; the cost for non residents is \$250.00. Call Circle High School at 316-536-2277 or 316-541-2277 for more information .
