**COVID EXPECTATIONS:**

- All spectators are allowed to attend - no pass list needed but we will use our clickers to keep count of attendance. Our attendance capacity at 50% is 750. We safely feel that we can accommodate all fans that want to attend and stay under our 50% capacity.
- All fans are allowed to attend all games
- Social distancing is required
- Masks are REQUIRED by all coaches, non-participating athletes, workers at the table, and fans at all times
- Only 3 per restroom at a time
- Only food allowed is either from concessions or prepackaged foods brought by the athlete (sack lunches/snacks)
- No food will be allowed in from anyone other than athletes
- Cleaning will be taking place between games, so please be patient and understanding with our custodial crews

The NSAA is implementing the following requirements for host schools of all NSAA fall sub-district, districts, and district finals:

- Participants are permitted to wear face coverings during competition, but not required.
