Dear GCS Families, Faculty and Staff,

The District was informed that a high school student has tested positive for COVID-19. This exposure is unrelated to the one shared yesterday.

The last time that the student was on campus was Thursday, January 21st. Per our health and safety protocols, Greenville Central School District has been in communication with the Greene County Department of Health to assist with the contact tracing process. Parents of students who are identified as being potentially exposed will be contacted by both the District and the Department of Health.

Due to the number of staff that may be quarantined due to this exposure, the 12th grade class will be remote on Friday, January 29th. Questar programming will continue for all students who are not quarantined.

Privacy laws restrict the District from disclosing or confirming any personally identifiable information.

It is important to continue to maintain personal awareness of COVID-19 symptoms and get tested if experiencing any symptoms.
