And they themselves will give you to drink from the sacred water, and afterward you shall be lord among the rest of the heroes.

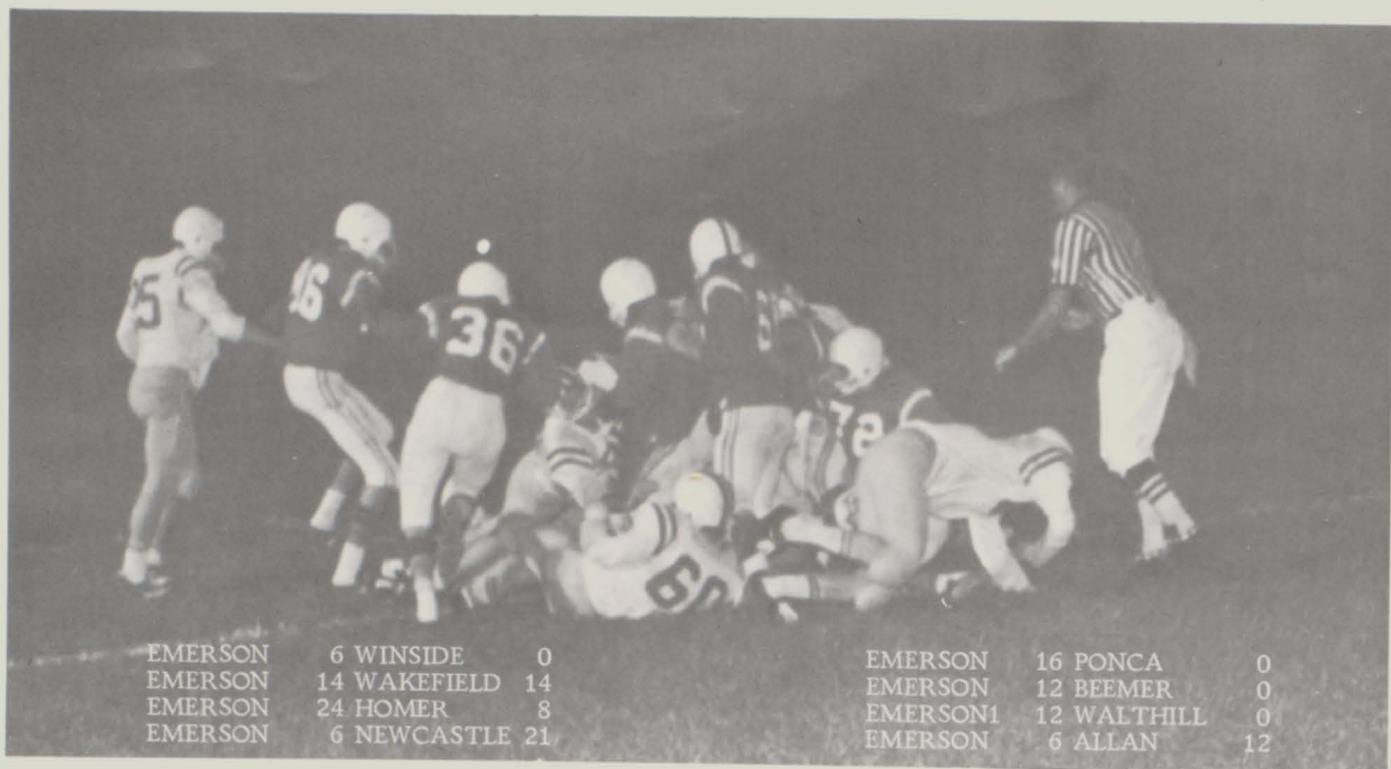

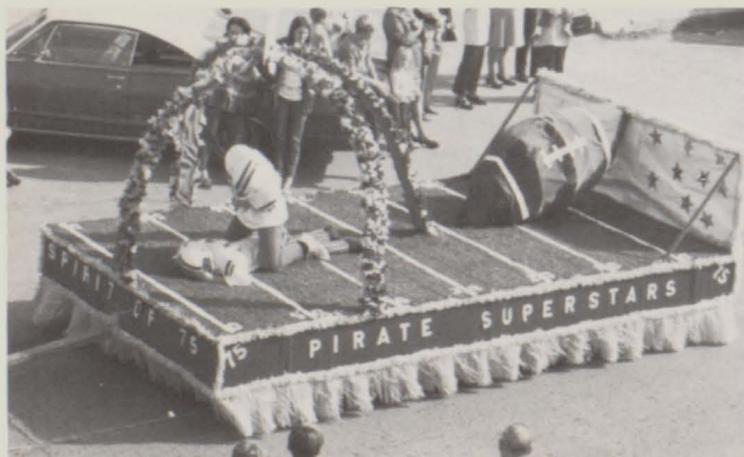

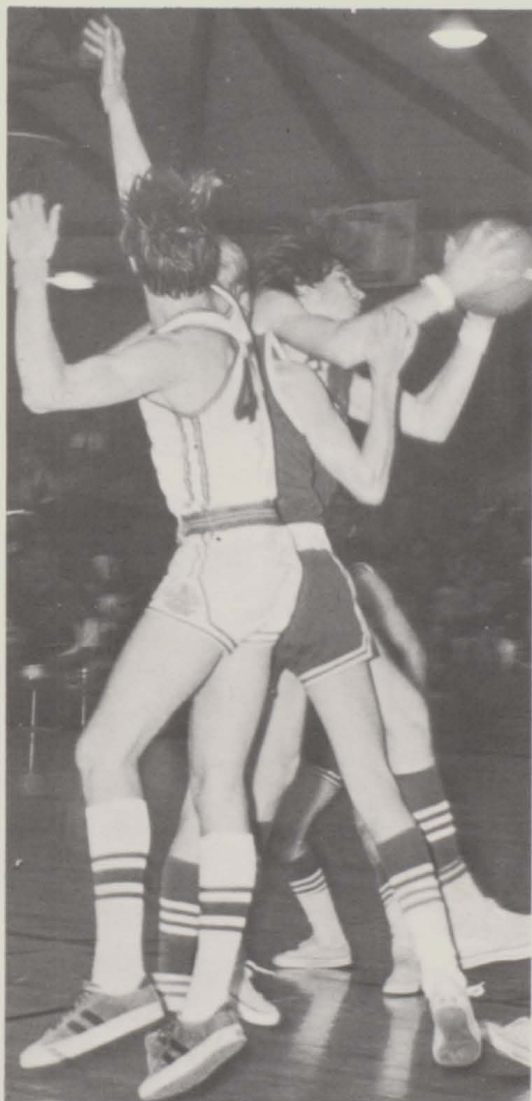
Cagers Win First Conference Titles

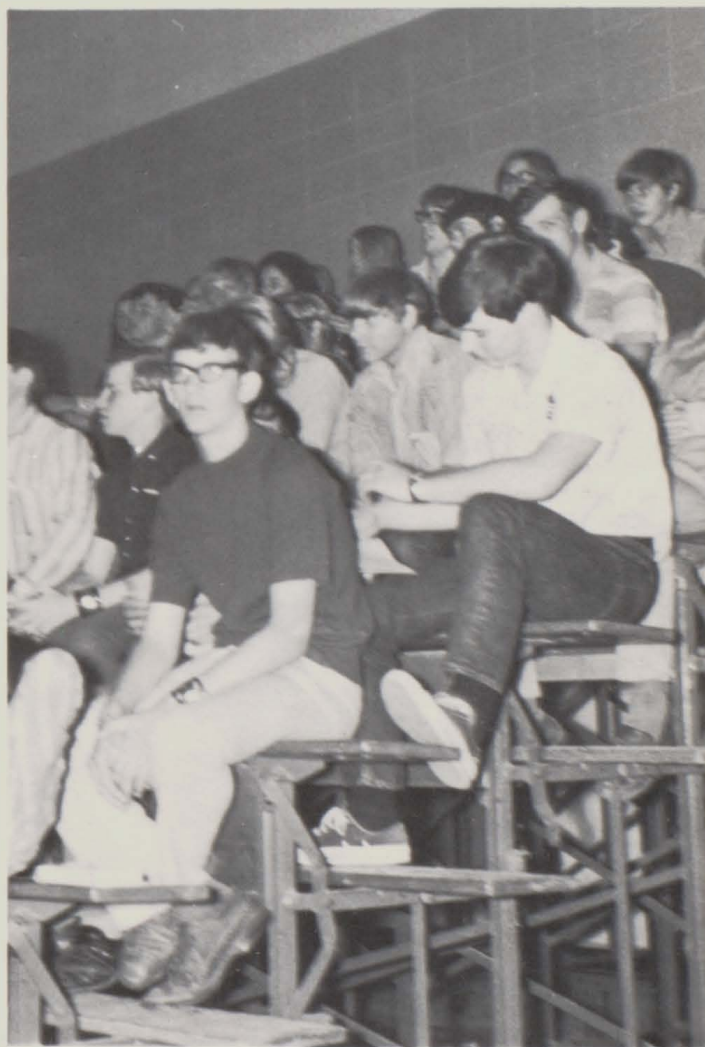
