WHEREAS, 4 individuals have nomination petitions with sufficient signatures to qualify as candidates; and

WHEREAS, the deadline for filing and affidavit of intent to be a write-in candidate has passed with 0 individual(s) filing such an affidavit; and

WHEREAS, state law at Colo. Rev. Stat. § 1-5-208 (1.5) authorizes the Board of Education by resolution to cancel the election and declare the candidates elected if at the close of business on September 1, 2015 there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at the election, including candidates filing affidavits of intent to be write-in candidates.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the **Center Consolidated School District 26JT** has determined that the prerequisites for canceling the election have been met so the 2015 regular school biennial election is canceled.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that **Richard J. Barela**, the designated election official for the regular school biennial election, is authorized to take all necessary appropriate steps to cancel the election, including providing notice of the cancellation by publication and by positing notice a each polling location, in the office of the designated election official and in the office of the county clerk and recorder; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the designated election official shall officially notify the county clerk and recorder of this action so that the election expenses to date can be pro-rated accordingly; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following individuals are hereby declared elected by acclamation: Yuridia Cendejas, Richard J. Barela, G. Lyn Bogle, Enrique R. Aguilar, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the designated election official shall notify these candidates of the cancellation of the election of their resulting election by acclamation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that between Election Day and the next regular meeting of the Board of Education or the Boards organizational meeting, whichever comes first, the designated election official shall provide these candidates with certificates of election after which they shall each take the oath of office within 10 days and will thereafter be qualified to participate in meetings of the Board of Education.
