NOTIFICATION OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 CASE ON CAMPUS

January 28, 2021

Dear Parent/Guardian,

In keeping with Jourdanton ISD's practices to respond to COVID-19, we are notifying all student families that a staff member who was confirmed to have COVID-19 was present on the campus of Jourdanton Junior High School on Tuesday, January 26, 2021. Due to privacy requirements, we will not be releasing the name of the individual or details that may identify him or her.

We are working closely with the local health department on this matter. After careful review, we have determined that the COVID-positive person did not come into contact with students, staff, or areas accessed by students or staff. Operations at Jourdanton Junior High School will continue as usual, and we will keep you apprised of further updates.

While we do not have reason to believe that those who were not in close contact with the infected individual have reason to be concerned, we ask that you, as always, to watch for symptoms of COVID-19.

Any of the following symptoms indicate a possible COVID-19 infection:

- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
- Loss of taste or smell
- Cough
- Difficulty breathing
- Shortness of breath
- Fatigue
- Headache
- Chills
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Shaking or exaggerated shivering
- Significant muscle pain or ache
- Diarrhea
- Nausea or vomiting
