



Kindergarten Supply List

Please have your child bring the following items with him/her to the Open House or on the first day of school. These essential items will be used throughout the year.

Large backpack

- 1 Package of Ticonderoga #2 pencils (sharpened if possible)
- 1 Pencil Box (plastic one that flips open-8"x 5")
- 4 Boxes of 24 crayons (Crayola)
- 4 Elmers glue sticks
- 2 marbled composition notebook (hardcover)
- 1 Pair of children's Fiskars scissors (with name on them)
- 1 set of headphones (not earbuds)
- 1 package of washable markers
- 1 box of quart or snack size Ziploc baggies (optional)

* Please only send in the items on this list as I don't have a lot of room to store extra items. Thanks!

In order to follow CDC guidelines, we believe students will need to keep their own supplies in their desks. It is unclear at this time whether sharing supplies will be possible, if we disinfect after using. We want to manage school supplies (we have plenty of scissors, glue and rulers) without asking parents to buy tons of things. Our philosophy will be, as much as possible, "keep it simple".

Erasers and colored pencils might be a helpful purchase.

If you choose to provide hand sanitizer for your child that is ok - we have a sink and plenty of soap in the classroom for hand washing.

We do not know at this time if face masks will be required. We are hoping to be able to avoid that - but at this time it is unknown.
