Re: Confirmed COVID-19 Case

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Unity School District was notified today that it has an individual who has tested positive for COVID-19. As stated in the Unity School Reopening Plan v2.1, the necessary health safety precautions identified by the CDC and DPI are being taken at the school.

The individual who has tested positive will be excluded from school. Children and staff who interacted closely with the individual will be contacted by the school nurse. These individuals will be quarantined and excluded from school for 7-, 10-, or 14-days from their last date of exposure to the positive individual.

The Learning Models remain unchanged at this time and Unity is in the In-Person Learning Model. Further COVID information regarding our schools may be found on the District website.

Coronavirus (COVID-19) is a virus that is spread even before individuals show symptoms. It spreads from person to person through droplets created when we cough, sneeze, talk, sing or laugh. Thus, it is ever important for all students, family members, and staff members to closely watch for symptoms that are outside of their "normal," and to stay home if they are ill. If symptoms occur, please contact your medical provider to request testing.

Please take these steps to slow the spread of COVID-19:

- 1. Stay home when ill.
- 2. Wear a face covering when in public if physically able.
- 3. Wash hands frequently with soap and water. Use hand sanitizer if soap and water are unavailable.
- 4. Clean frequently touched surfaces, such as doorknobs, tables, etc.
