BV SCHOOLS Weekly Update – February 1, 2021

The School District will continue its weekly update to keep families updated with information about school re-opening and COVID-19 impacts. We understand that while we have all anticipated and prepared for possible shifts in learning, as disruptions occur, it can be unsettling. The weekly update is intended to keep you informed. Please remember you can always access county health data related to COVID on a public dashboard at the county website.



Health Update: Across the district, we have had several confirmed positive cases impacting our schools and increasing needed quarantines.

On Monday, February 1 district operations will be as follows:

Grove and Avery Parsons: “pause day” with no remote learning;

BVMS and BVHS: Remote Learning Day;

CCHS: Remote “Enrichment” Day. **Lunch is available for order and pick up between 12-1 pm.** See below for specific information.

The district will test some students and staff on Monday as part of our on-going mitigation strategies and efforts to sustain in-person learning. The students who may voluntarily be tested have been notified.

All schools are scheduled to return to in-person learning on Tuesday, February 2nd.

LUNCH Order for February 1

BVMS, BVHS, CCHS: Use the Remote Learning Scanner to log in attendance and order a lunch. Pick up off of Marquette at the Athletic Commons entrance.

From our school nurses: The recent cases have presented as “stuffy noses” and small colds. Please remember to keep your child home with even minor symptoms. This will always be our very best strategy in keeping each other healthy, even when COVID is not so much a part of our everyday experience. When we each stay home when sick, we limit spread most importantly, but also reduce those who need to be quarantined.

The District will shift to general reporting of cases, rather than a specific count by school in coming weeks. We will continue weekly communication both through updates and Zoom calls.

We also plan to include District “good to knows” beyond COVID in our weekly Zoom calls. This includes information about our district priorities, state testing, and other plans for the future. Please join us when you are able on Monday evenings, 5:00-5:30 pm. Information to join is below.

BV Schools Health Status of February 1, 2021

- There are 4 new positive cases within the school community at this time.
- Positive cases, including students and staff:
 - Grove - 0
 - AvPar - 3
 - BVMS - 4
 - BVHS - 2
 - CCHS - 0
- Schools continue to be a low risk gathering considering there is no confirmed transmission within school. The strong risk mitigation practices we, and other district have in place, are allowing our students to be in-person.
- BV Schools is responsible for monitoring and evaluating “close contacts” related to school activities with the Response Team. While we support contact tracing of Public Health, we are not responsible for tracing or reporting of possible contacts outside of school activities.
- To achieve the goal of in-person learning throughout the school year, we urge families to follow good health practices.

Comprehensive Post-Secondary Readiness (CPSR) Program Evaluation:

As part of our five year cycle of reviewing each of our programs, we are currently evaluating our programming specifically intended for post-secondary readiness - the skills and qualities for success not matter choices after high school. Industrial Arts, Foods, our Seminar classes, advisory, business courses, Civics - these are samples of the courses especially examined in the process. We have sent surveys to our alumni, will be administering a survey to our current students, are meeting with business community to gain insight into needs and perspectives.
