Request to the Department of Public Instruction for a Waiver of Certain Statutory and Regulatory Requirements for the 2020-2021 School Year.

- Public hearing, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §118.38(1)(b), regarding submission of a request to the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) to waive the following statutory and regulatory requirements for the 2020-2021 school year due to the ongoing COVID-19 public health emergency:

 - G. Health, Physical Education, Art, and Music, Wis. Stat. § 121.02(1)(j).
 - H. Curriculum Plans, Wis. Stat. § 121.02(1)(k).
 - I. Regular Instruction, Wis. Stats. § 121.02(1)(L) and § 253.15(5).
 - J. School Attendance Enforcement, Wis. Stats. § 118.16 and § 118.162.
 - K. Pupil Participation in School Activities, Wis. Stat. § 120.12(23).
 - L. Guidance and Counseling, Wis. Stat. §121.02(1)(e).
 - M. Gifted and Talented Programs, Wis. Stats. § 118.35 and § 121.02(1)(t).
- As part of the public hearing, the Board will review in-person and written comments from members of the public regarding the request for the waiver, before discussing and taking action regarding the request for a waiver.

Written comments must be received by Tuesday, February 9th at noon to be included. Any received after this date and time, may not be reviewed at the hearing.
- The Board will consider action to adopt a resolution to authorize the administration to request a waiver from DPI for any or all of the above-referenced statutory and regulatory requirements for the 2020-2021 school year due to the ongoing COVID-19 public health emergency.
