The following guidelines will be in place and are expected to be followed. Failure to adhere to these guidelines will result in an invitation to leave our facility.

#### ☐ MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES

- Failure to follow IDPH guidelines will result in immediate removal
- ☐ Spectators will check in at the table outside the gym
- ☐ There will be separate Spectator Rosters for each level (7th, 8th, Fr/JV, Varsity)
- ☐ Spectators will not be allowed into the game without the proper authorization
  - Spectators should not expect entry until 15 minutes prior to scheduled start times, or when the doors are opened for entry
  - Spectators will only be able to watch the game in which their child is participating due to restrictions.
    - Senior Boy Basketball Players, Sr. Cheerleader and Sr. Dance will be allowed 2 Fans per participant (Varsity Games)
    - Junior/Sophomore Boys Basketball Players, Cheerleaders and Dance will be allowed 1 Fan per participant (JV Games)
    - Freshman Boys / Girls Basketball will be allowed 2 Fans per participant (Freshman Only Games)
    - HS Girls Basketball, MS Volleyball will be allowed 2 Fans per participant
    - MS Boys Basketball, MS Cheer & Dance will be allowed 1 Fan per

participant • Boys Swim – 2 Fans per participant Spectators can expect to have their temperatures taken. If you have a temperature of 100.4 Fahrenheit or greater, you will be asked to leave the building. ☐ The gym will be cleared immediately at the conclusion of the game Spectators for prelim games (7th, Fr/JV) should exit the gym and return to their vehicles • No gathering in the gym, or outside • MS Gym spectators will exit the south door of the gym • HS Gym spectators will exit the same entry doors and then leave the building using the weight room entry. ☐ The bleachers/seating areas will be disinfected between games ☐ The ONLY Spectator Entrance to \* HS gym will be the Main entrance off of the HS side. \* MS Gym entrance will be the main entrance to the MS side of the building. ☐ Upon entry, please proceed to the designated seating area and sit on a marked space (represented by a sticker) that is socially distanced from other spectators. Members of the same household may sit together. ☐ Gym Doors will remain closed, except for 15 minutes initial entry and will be checked periodically throughout the game. Late arrivals are okay, but do not expect immediate entry. □ No Concessions will be available at this time. No Food or Drink allowed in Gyms. ☐ Restrooms are located • Off the main entrance hallway to the right in the HS (across from HS office). • In the MS they are located on the East side of the gym (8th grade hallway).
