Hybrid Model

Gardner Edgerton USD 231

- Students at the secondary level (grades 6 - 12) are able to return to in-person instruction in a hybrid format.
- This return is possible as a result of recommendations made by Johnson County Health and Environment (JCHE), Kansas State Department of Education (KSDE), Kansas State Department of Health and Environment (KDHE).
- Also, this return is due in large part to the success in preventing COVID-19 transmission in our schools.

OVERVIEW

Grades 6 - 9 Will return to in-person learning using the hybrid model on Monday, February 8, 2021. *Students in grades 10 - 12 will not attend remotely. No school.*

Grades 10 - 12 Will return to in-person learning using the hybrid model on Tuesday, February 9, 2021. This will allow freshmen to become familiar with the building prior to the return of students in the upper grades.

Elementary students (grades PK - 5) will continue with in-person learning. Students whose families have selected remote learning will remain remote.

GARDNER EDGERTON HIGH SCHOOL

- During hybrid learning, students will attend on-site based on their last name, and receive asynchronous activities, with some exceptions (primarily AP/College Now Courses), during their “off day”.
- During “off days” students will be required to check-in during seminar via Zoom with their assigned teacher.
- Special education services will continue as detailed in the child’s Individual Education Plan (IEP). If the IEP has established an Alternate Service Plan, those services will continue as outlined.

MIDDLE SCHOOL (GRADES 6 - 8)

** 5th Grade will still attend on-site daily*

- During hybrid learning, students with last names (A-L) will attend on-site Monday and Wednesday, and receive asynchronous activities after a teacher check-in on Tuesday and Thursday.
- Students with last names (M-Z) attend on-site Tuesday and Thursday and receive asynchronous activities after a teacher check-in on Monday and Wednesday.
- On Fridays, all students will learn remotely.
- In addition, some students may work on-site in small groups on Fridays, as determined by academic needs.
- Special education services will continue as detailed in the child's Individual Education Plan (IEP). If the IEP has established an Alternate Service Plan, those services will continue as outlined.

- Students will have assignments to complete independently on each teachers' Google Classroom or Schoology page.
- All Grade 6-8 students will follow their schedules Friday for virtual classes

Meals - Middle and High School

- Meals will be provided on-site on the days that students are in session.
- Beginning Tuesday, February 15, a free weekly meal kit containing 3 breakfasts and 3 lunches will be available for students to pick up at the end of the school day on the first day of scheduled attendance (example: Group One picks up on Monday, Group Two picks up on Tuesday).
- No pre-order is required.

Middle School Sports

- Track Season Starts March 1
- During Hybrid: Students will attend practice after school on their attendance days. Friday practice will be optional.
- We will participate in Frontier League competitions
- All Covid protocol will be followed at practice and meets including athletes wearing masks.
- We will share spectator information as soon as KSHSAA and the Frontier League release that information
