Parents,

Through a unique partnership of several area school districts and Minnesota West Community and Technical College, 2020-2021 sophomores and juniors have the opportunity to take a college class, **free** to students, from June 7 -July 2, 2021.

The summer college credit program provides 2020-2021 sophomore and junior students who meet the post-secondary enrollment option criteria, to take one summer college course and earn college credit from a nationally accredited institution. By taking this course in the summer it allows students to focus on one college level course in a condensed time frame and experience the rigor of college level courses in the safety of an all high school student setting. The PSEO enrollment criteria is met for seniors in the upper 1/2 of their class and juniors in the upper 1/3 of their class. If a student does not meet the PSEO requirements they may still qualify to take the course by passing the ACCUPLACER test through Minnesota West.

What courses are offered?

- 1) BUS 1101, Introduction to Business is a 4 credit course that provides students with vital exposure to the major business functions in a dynamic free enterprise environment. The course offers students relevant exposure to background information necessary to execute decision making in a multitude of business specialties. Fundamentals are emphasized in areas such as management, marketing, financing, and information systems. This class will meet on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 8:00am-12:00 noon. There will be online work requirements to be completed during the remainder of the week.
- 2) CJS 1101, Intro to Criminal Justice is a 3 credit course that Introduces students to the criminal justice system. The primary goal of this course is to develop a general understanding of the criminal justice system and its response to crime in society today. Students will consider crime in the U.S, explore the key elements of the criminal justice system (policing, courts, and corrections), and examine a number of special issues relevant to criminal justice today. This course is part of the Minnesota State transfer pathways. This class will meet on Tuesday and Wednesday from 8:00am-12:00 noon. There will be online work requirements to be completed during the remainder of the week.

Where are the courses offered?

In person sessions will meet at Marshall High School on the designated classroom days.

What do I do if I am interested in taking advantage of this opportunity?

Students must contact their school counselor and she will assist getting students registered. Once registered it is expected students complete the course as fees are non-refundable to the school. Once registered, students must complete the post-secondary enrollment option application to Mn West (our school counselor will assist with this). Remember to use your current Star ID and password if you already have one when registering with Mn West.
