- <u>Barrington School Free Flu Clinics</u> October 2020, by Wellness Company-Must pre-register and no walk-ins this year; Protocols in place for social distancing, masks required, attestation prior to entering, and other safety measures enforced. Register at Schoolflu.com

 - Sowams Elementary School 10/29/20 4-7pm
- BPS Certified School Nurse Teachers Department team meetings have occurred throughout summer and regularly for school entry and with Dr. Parker consulting school physician for guidance on protocols of health and safety for COVID-19 school reentry planning
- RIDOH Portal for Probable Cases of COVID-19- CNSTs entering data for each school for contact tracing
- Building Substitute School Nurses Float pool -Currently interviewing substitute school nurses
- Certified Nursing Assistants (CNA's) hired for each school to assist nurses with isolation rooms and various duties related to COVID-19 building needs
- **Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)** District secured appropriate PPE for staff as appropriate; Ongoing planning for PPE for schools looking at supply, demand and usage
- Isolation Tents were secured for each building/Last weeks wind storm knocked down; Utilizing isolation rooms in each building currently as needed
- Updated Outbreak Response Protocols Pre K-12 10/1/2020; Guidance for COVID-19
 Outbreak Response "Playbook"; CSNTs working with RIDOH ongoing communication to staff/families
- Utilizing <u>After-Illness Return Attestation</u> form for students symptomatic or probable returning to school

- **Hearing Screenings** Scheduled by RI School for the Deaf in November
 - Hearing Screenings are mandated through RIDOH Rules & Regs for School Health Programs for students PK-3rd grades; Cancelled last Spring SY 2019-2020 due to COVID-19; Pending Superintendent approval if satisfactory safety precautions met
