- October Drug Take Back-407 lbs of expired/unused medication collected from 44 people. 6200 lbs collected statewide. Anyone in need of Deterra bags or Dispose Rx can contact Denise at The BAY Team.
- 2. Our East Bay Tobacco Youth Council held the regional youth conference on 10/17 for new members in the region. They received 2 training components-Taking Down Tobacco and Rise of Vaping as well as taking part in a vape escape room and learning about presentations the youth council does.
- 3. The Day of Caring, October 12th -15 volunteers collected 1700 lbs of food from 66 families who dropped off for Tap-In at Barrington Town Hall.
- 4. Distributed retailer education with age verification calendars to those who hold a tobacco retail license in town. There has been an increase in sales to minors.
- 5. We are working with Barrington Police to conduct compliance checks in November and December.
- 6. We have scheduled the next Youth Awareness class in mid-November. This class is for anyone under 21 with an alcohol offense. Barrington Police found another "camp" behind Hampden Meadows School.
- 7. We are launching our new website, "Raise Your Hand". Parents will be able to email questions that will be answered in a blog form by student assistance counselors, social workers.
