On motion of Roy M. Wilson, seconded by Vera D. Lindsey, Roosevelt Stalvey was elected Chairman; and on motion of Elvin Mathews, seconded by Roy M. Wilson, Clyde Townsend was elected Vice Chairman of said District School Board for the County of Gilchrist, State of Florida.

Eli M. Read, holding commission as Superintendent of Schools for the ensuing 1 year appeared in person at said meeting and assumed his duties as Secretary of the Board, as provided by law. The Board thus organized then decided on the first Tuesday of each month as the day for holding its regular monthly meetings.

SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION

Paras Associates Architects Inc., Tampa, Florida presented preliminary plans for the new construction in the county schools.

The Board viewed the plans and upon motion by Clyde Townsend and second by Roy M. Wilson approved the preliminary plans which will go to the State Department of Education for their approval, after which final drawings will be made.
