Distribution of Scholarships

Qualifications

Any high school senior that will be advancing his/her education by attending a school for two semesters (quarters) or more is eligible to apply. This includes technical schools as well as colleges and universities. The scholarships are intended for men and women entering the fields relating to the Beef Industry such as agriculture, nutrition, etc.

Applications will be taken from a student whose family is a member of the O'Brien County Cattlemen's Assn.

Selection Process

The first step in the selection process is to fill out an application and send off by by March 31, 2021. Interviews may be held if determined necessary by the board members. Scholarship winners will be announced in early May.

Scholarship applications will be judged on the basis of the student's past accomplishments and future area of study. Particular emphasis will be placed on the student's area of study and how his/her education in that field will benefit the Beef Industry.

Actual payment will be made during the winter break after it has been determined that each scholarship winner is progressing acceptably in the area of study stated on the scholarship application.
