Count UP is a free after-school math tutoring program for K-12 students in Central Arkansas. Through this program, created by the Central Arkansas Library System and supported by the Walton Family Foundation, experienced tutors are matched with students to provide personalized support and guidance.

VOLUNTEER TUTORING

Our tutors will work with students to provide assistance with homework, build foundational math and study skills, and explore student interests. Tutoring will be available in one-on-one and group formats to accommodate student learning preferences. Students and tutors will have access to a variety of digital tools and eLearning platforms, including Brainfuse HelpNow. Brainfuse is available 24/7 with any library card or tech card and offers assessment tests, study activities, games, tools for collaborative learning, practice challenges, and more. Depending on availability and preference, volunteers are also welcome to work with families to provide digital literacy assistance, college and career preparation, and community building in English and Spanish. We are particularly looking for volunteers with teaching experience or math-related experience in STEM and other fields, students working towards education degrees and certifications, and bilingual individuals.

ELIGIBILITY

- Tutors must be 16 years or older
- Tutors must pass a background check
- Tutors must attend volunteer training
- Tutors must have regular availability on at least one weekday afternoon and/or Saturday each week
