Seminole Public Schools have been notified of a student in the 7<sup>th</sup> grade and 8<sup>th</sup> grade at Seminole Middle School who tested positive for COVID-19. Individuals testing positive are required to isolate for 10-days and will be notified by the local health department.

Contact tracing for the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade is complete. First level contacts (anyone who is identified to have been within 6 feet of the positive individual for 15 minutes or longer at any time during the virus infectious period) will be required to quarantine according to CDC guidelines. Quarantine is required after contact with a positive person for 10 days without a COVID-19 test and no symptoms. All students and families have been notified at this time and have been moved to Distance Learning status during the isolation/quarantine periods.
