The committee has recently approved a new leadership team and reviewed its purpose and role, along with its by-laws, with the general membership. Highlights of the mission include providing recommendations to the School Committee and helping to set strategic goals within the district. The committee has also begun discussion of future topics to consider, including the IEP process, revisiting school safety protocols, transition of fully remote students to in-person, and resources to help high needs students on snow days/professional development days.
