Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Who is eligible to ride the bus?

A. USD 480 regulations/guidelines are if you reside outside of a set radius, as the crow flies, from your attendance center; or, if you are asked to attend a school outside of your boundary; or, if your child is attending preschool; or, if the child qualifies under “special needs”. Set radius is as follows: K-5TH (1) mile, 6th-8th (1.5) miles. 9th-12th is (2.5) miles as traveled by bus route.

Q. How do I request transportation for my child?

A. Fill out a Bus Rider Application Form and hand it in during enrollment. A determination is made from the information verified on this form. Bus rider applications can also be filled out at the school or at the bus barn.

Q. Is USD 480 required to bus my child no matter what?

A. No. If the need exceeds the number of seats available, students who live within the set area to 2 ½ mile radius may be excluded. The Kansas State Board of Education Regulations require busing only outside of the 2 ½ mile radius, or if the student requires special needs transportation.

Q. I live in one school boundary, but have enrolled my child in a school past the set mileage from my home. Can my child ride the bus?

A. NO. If you choose to send your child to a different school, the District cannot provide transportation.

Q. If my child qualifies to ride the bus, can I dictate what time they are picked up and dropped off?

A. No. Due to the complexity of routing several buses and several hundred children, route times are determined after the all rider’s information is entered and may change with little notification.

Q. Do the buses have video cameras on them?

A. YES. All buses are equipped with a state of the art DVR/GPS system.
