Dear Parents/Guardians and Ridgedale Community:

I am hoping that you all are finally dug out from the recent winter storm from earlier this week and are preparing for the next potential storm coming next Monday and Tuesday. We have had a great two weeks back with all of our students! It is wonderful to hear the hallways alive and to see all of our fantastic students. We will continue in this learning model for the remainder of the school year unless instructed otherwise directed from the those holding State level offices. We heard from the Governor's office that the Ridgedale staff will receive the first round of the Covid-19 vaccine, **tentatively**, Friday February 26, 2021, but we have not yet been assigned a vaccination time for our staff. As soon as our times are finalized I will let the staff and community know in case the vaccinations are taking place on a school day. I am hoping that we are scheduled for after school but we will not be given a choice of time. **As a reminder these plans are always subject to change based on public health recommendations or by Governor order.**

I would like to thank all of our parents and guardians that are dropping off or picking up their children for adjusting to the new procedures that have been put into place. This process will continue to get smoother and more efficient moving forward. As a reminder we are asking that all parents remain in their cars during this time. **Reminder Elementary doors do not open until 7:45 a.m.**

1. There will be **no parking** for drop-off/pick-up of students. This causes our students and parents to cross traffic that is waiting in the line and could result in a serious injury to students, parents or staff.
2. All morning drop-off of students will take place at the cross walk, near the yellow poles, between the elementary school and the Jr/Sr high school. We will no longer be dropping off at the back door of the elementary.
3. All afternoon pick-up will take place at the cross walk, near the yellow poles, between the elementary school and the Jr/Sr high school. The staff will no longer be walking our student through the car line after school to find their ride. **Jr/Sr High students will be picked up at the lower level gymnasium entrance.**
4. Upon exiting the parking lot please continue through the lower level parking lot and exit using the North drive

[www.ridgedaleschools.org](http://www.ridgedaleschools.org), there you will find the district and state of Ohio schools Covid-19 dashboard, which will inform you of all school age Covid-19 cases, at Ridgedale and across the entire state, this dashboard is updated weekly. Currently we have 3 positive Jr/Sr High School student cases and 15 students in quarantine, all through athletic participation, with 0 positive elementary student cases and 2 elementary student in quarantine. We have 0 Jr/Sr High staff positive cases and 1 Jr/Sr High staff member in quarantine, with 0 elementary staff member positive with 0 staff members quarantined at this time. Ridgedale is still be responsible for contact tracing and quarantining of students and staff. Even though the Governor and ODH have relaxed quarantine rules, this does not mean that your student may need to quarantine in the future. If your child will need to quarantine you will be hearing from our school nurse, Mr. Jon Campbell, or the building office, and not Marion Public Health. Marion Public Health is now following the most recent Governor and ODH guidance for quarantine, and is listed in the link below. If there is a need to quarantine we will be relaying to you how long your child's quarantine will last.
