


Baraga Area Schools Board Presentation October 2022 Updated March 2023

Future Supports with 98c

- SEL Intervention Staff to support emotional wellness K-5
 - Staff to assist in emotional well being of grades K-5 to support emotional health, which should in turn increase student engagement in academics
 - "When SEL is implemented in schools systematically and with fidelity, children make learning gains." ¹

(note: the above will be partially/fully covered using 98c funds)

Impact

• SEL supports will be monitored by number of office referrals before the program vs. after the program is implemented. A survey of mental health needs/improvements can be used. This increased emotional support should also in turn increase academic proficiency.

Review & Revision

- The school will review our school improvement plan during the year and adjust goals yearly to ensure they align with the needs of the students and the district vision and mission.
