Arrey Community Schools Pantry has served 76 households; 159 adults, 25 senior citizens and 113 Children in the month of January 2021 for a total of 297 individuals combined.

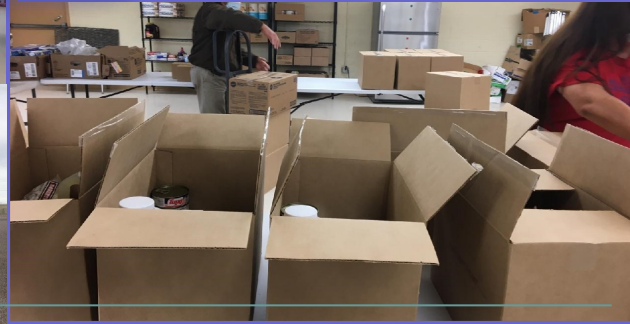
Arrey Community Schools has served 61 of our 91 current student body with case management type services.
