

LHS Basketball Etiquette

- ALL students **MUST** have their school ID!
- Campus, the only people with court side seats will be administrators, officers and David Stanley. All club/organization sponsors will also sit in the bleachers during the game. (No, extra chairs, couches, etc. will be allowed. Fans, coaches, and teachers will sit in the bleachers to cheer the basketball teams to victory.) For security, administrators and Officers must have immediate access to problems areas during the game. Also, our athletic trainer must be able to help the students with injuries.
- All fans must pay for admittance to the game. Therefore, athletes will not be allowed free admittance when it is not their season. For example, football players will not be allowed free admittance to basketball games. Performers will need to continue to provide lists of names to the gate for admittance to the games.
- All performers such as: cheerleaders, scream team, etc. must have a sponsor prepared list that is given to the gate prior to the game.
- Fans will not be allowed to enter from the north hallway in the building. All fans must enter through the front door of the gym.
- Any person who leaves to game must pay to reenter the game.
- **No Loitering**
- ***During the game, outside food and drinks will not be allowed in the gym.***
- On the first floor of the gym, the scream team must stand on the second row bleachers, from the floor in the gym. On the first floor of the gym, all students and fans will sit on and stand on the second row of bleachers. (The players can sit on the first row of the bleachers.)
- Only LHS players & coaches are allowed to sit on the LHS bench or in the chairs that are designated for the LHS teams.
- Volunteers at the gate will need to get a radio from the front office prior to the game.
- Administrators who will be escorted by Officers will secure the funds after the games. (Administrators see Dr. DeLoach for instructions.)

NOTE: Any fan, student or player can be subjected to a search during the game.

LHS supporters, remember that our goal at a basketball game is to cheer for the wonderful athletes that we have at LHS. We do not want to do negative things that will distract from the enjoyment of the basketball games.
