5 – 1 subject notebooks  
2 Highlighters - different colors  
1 Assignment Notebook/Planner  
10 Black or Blue Pens  
5 Red Pens  
5 Heavy Duty Laminated Pocket Folders or a 10 in 1 folder (available for purchase at registration for \$4.00 and recommended for eighth grade)  
10 - #2 Pencils  
1 Texas Instrument (TI-30xa) Solar Scientific calculator – (Must have fraction key)  
1 Pair of Earbuds  
1 Small Pink Eraser  
1 Container Pencil Lead if using refill pencils  
Loose leaf paper  
Stick Glue, markers and colored pencils for class projects (keep in lockers)  
1 container of Lysol/Clorox Wipes  
1 Bottle Hand Sanitizer (6<sup>th</sup> grade only)  
Maroon shorts and white or grey t-shirt for P.E. class  
(NO Trapper-Keepers – There is no room in junior high lockers for them)

### **Junior High Students Suggestions for your SUPPLY LIST**

1. Buy solid color coordinating folders and book covers. By doing this you'll know everything red in your locker is for English, everything blue in your locker is for Math, everything green in your locker is for Science, etc. When things match it's easier to find! Put your name on everything! Label folders/book covers with subject.
2. Buy durable folders – Ones that will last the ENTIRE school year without ripping or breaking when they are being moved around from your locker to your backpack to class. Paper folders, even the laminated ones, don't last very long!
3. Buy a durable plastic pencil bag to keep pencils, pens, highlighters, erasers, ear buds and your calculator in. You will only have to grab the bag out of your locker and you are set for class!
4. Inventory your school supplies each quarter. Restock pens and pencils and other supplies when you run out.
