Finalized 2022 GMAS results released

The Georgia Department of Education released final Georgia Milestone Assessment data for 2021-2022 on Friday July 22. The Charlton County School District is pleased to report outstanding student performance in a number of areas. The highlights are below.

Charlton County Schools ranked <u>1st</u> among all districts in the Okefenokee RESA (the 9 county area of Atkinson, Bacon, Brantley, Camden, Charlton, Clinch, Coffee, Pierce, and Ware Counties) in the following areas:

- 3rd grade Reading
- 3rd grade English Language Arts
- High School US History

Charlton ranked in the top 30% of all school districts in Georgia in 11 of the 26 areas assessed by the GMAS.

Additionally, in the School Digger district rankings found at www.schooldigger.com, the Charlton County School District moved up 19 spots from last year's rankings. This was more progress than all but 11 traditional public school districts in Georgia, earning Charlton County its highest district ranking since the inception of the School Digger ranking system in 2006-2007.
