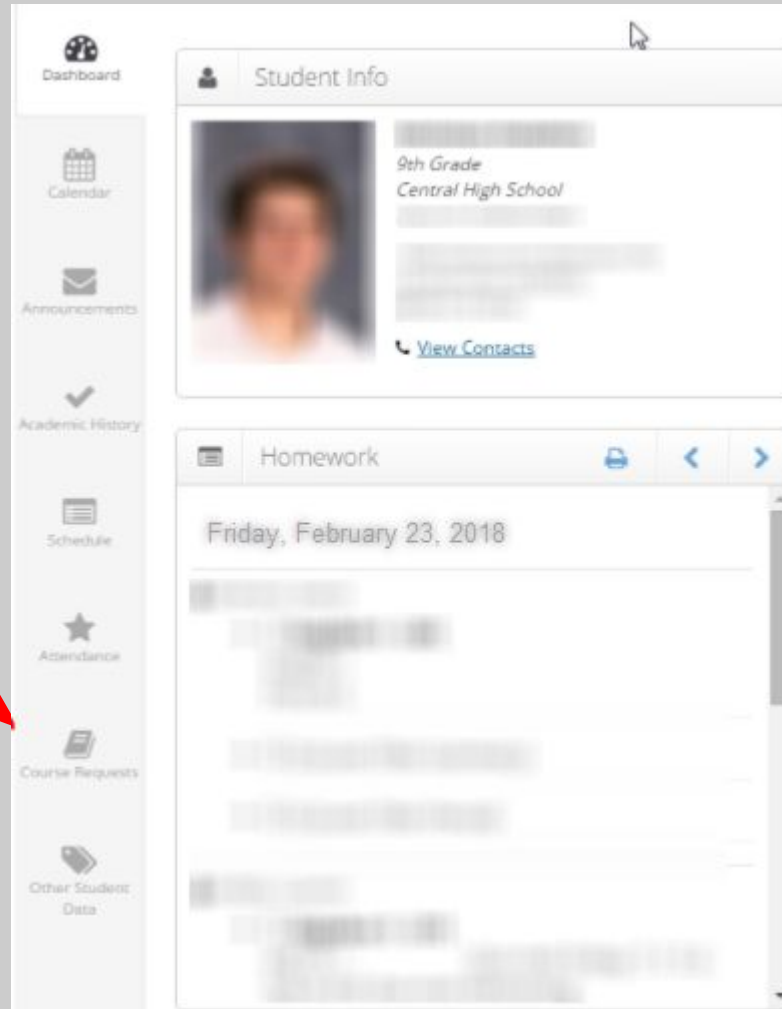
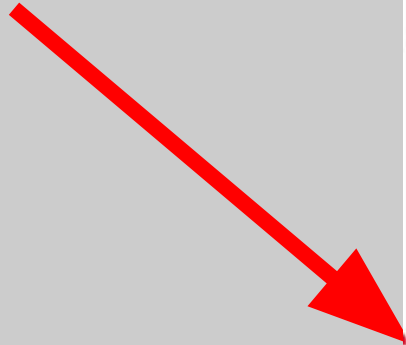



Choosing Courses

- There will be a course listed on your “Course Request” page for each academic subject (English, Math, Science, Social Studies, World Languages).
- If you think you are eligible for a course that doesn’t appear on the list, speak to your teacher to discuss if that option is right for you.
- When registering for electives in the visual & performing arts and practical arts, graduation requirements include:
 - 5 credits in the visual & performing arts (music, art, theater)
 - 5 credits in practical arts (business, family and consumer sciences, tech, industrial arts).
 - 2.5 credits in personal finance or American Economics

2021 - 2022 HVCHS Program of Studies & Academic Placement Waiver Form

The 2021 - 2022 HVCHS Program of Studies is a great resource as you prepare for your course selection meeting and make your course selections in Oncourse.

If a student does not meet the grade eligibility requirement after the 2nd marking period, the student will need to complete the academic placement waiver form to request a change in placement. **The deadline to submit an academic placement waiver form is April 12, 2021.** Due to our remote/hybrid schedule, we converted the paper form into a google form to assist students. Course Selection Meeting Timeline by Grade

Current 8th Grade: February 22, 2021 - February 25, 2021

Current 9th Grade: March 1, 2021 - March 12, 2021

Current 10th Grade: March 15, 2021 - March 26, 2021

Current 11th Grade: April 5, 2021 - April 12, 2021

All students will receive an sign up genius email link one week prior to the designated time frame for that specific grade. Students will be able to select the day and time that works best for their schedule to have their course selection zoom meeting with their school counselor. Please note that the above timeline is tentative for the current 9th - 11th grade students. If our school counselors finish a grade earlier than the allotted timeline, we will communicate to the next group of students that we will start their meetings earlier. Our current 8th grade students are confirmed to have their course selection meetings from February 22nd - February 25th. Due to remote and zoom coordination, we added additional time this year to see all students.
