BOARD MEMBERS' REQUEST FOR INFORMATION

The R.S.U. No. 67 Board of Directors may request information from the administration, who recognizes its responsibility to provide individual Board members with such information as requested. This information should assist the Board members in their overall general knowledge of R.S.U. No. 67 and/or assist the member who anticipates having to vote on a pending issue. When requests are determined to require significant administration time, the Superintendent and Board Chairperson will consult to determine an appropriate course of action.

It is the intent of this policy to encourage Board members who initiate the request for information, material, data and/or research, to obtain support from the majority of the Board of Directors by utilizing the agenda item entitled, "Items requested from Board members, community and staff to be printed on the next agenda", particularly when the requested information will require significant administrative time, effort and/or expense.

This policy is designed to discourage individual Board members from unnecessarily utilizing administrator's time when the request will not be beneficial to the entire Board of Directors' responsibilities.
