After back and forth meet wins, Northern Cass finished second in the West Central Division to Alexandria followed by teams from Moorhead, Fergus Falls, Pelican Rapids and Breckenridge. The division awards for individual achievement include Ben 12th, Jordan 4th and Nolan 1st.
