Dear Woodbridge Township Parent/Guardians:

We hope this letter finds you healthy and safe. Today, Governor Murphy announced that a limited number of parents/guardians will be allowed to attend **indoor** high school athletic events, in-person. Our district has established the procedures below to be followed at all WTSD athletic events beginning tomorrow, February 13, 2021:

1. **Two** parents/guardians per participant from the **home team only** will be allowed to attend in-person as spectators within our campuses.
2. All spectators will be screened before entering the building. Spectators who register a temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher will not be permitted entry.
3. Spectators are asked not to arrive more than 15 minutes prior to the start of the contest.
4. Spectators are permitted to be present for their child's event only and must vacate the premise immediately upon the conclusion of the contest.
5. Masks must be worn at all times.
6. Spectator groups must remain socially distanced and sit in the designated areas and spaces.
7. Spectators must remain in their seats (exception would be to use the restroom).
8. Under **no circumstance** will spectators be permitted near any players or participants.
9. Anyone who is currently quarantining or has experienced any COVID symptoms is expected to stay home.
10. Games will still be live streamed.

Any spectator deemed in violation of any of the rules outlined above, will be escorted from the gym and banned from all remaining events for the rest of the 2020-2021 school year.

We fully anticipate the cooperation of our families. It is essential that we follow all safety procedures in order to keep our athletic programs running, as well as to prevent any outbreaks or the spread of Covid-19. We have been given the opportunity to allow spectators at our events and believe that we can work together to sustain this effort.
