Cheer and Band. There will be no cheer or band allowed due to crowd restrictions.

Divisional Basketball will be held in Butte starting on 2/25 – 2/27 with play-in games taking place on 2/22 at home sites. The girls will be held at the MAC and the boys at the Civic Center. Each team will be allotted only 40 tickets meaning that only 2 per player. Tickets will not be able to be used at both sites, they will be separate for boys and girls.

State Wrestling will be in Miles City on March 5th and 6th, State Swim will be in Great Falls on March 5th and State Basketball is currently scheduled for Butte on March 11th – 13th. I will have results from all of these events for you in my next board report.

Spring sports will get underway on March 15th and we are yet to have any guidance from MHSA on restrictions for competitions.
