IMPORTANT DATES, TIMES AND INFORMATION FOR HARRISON COUNTY SCHOOLS

 We will remain in the Hybrid model as we are currently operating until at least one full instructional week after all school personnel have the opportunity to receive the second vaccine dose.

<u>NOTE:</u> The first opportunity for staff to receive their second dose of the vaccine will be on Friday - February 19 <u>OR</u> Friday - February 26 (depending on availability of the vaccines). When the date is confirmed, Harrison County Schools will notify all students' families. The reason for the advance notice is so that students and families can plan for a virtual/remote instruction day that Friday.

- If the improvement of COVID conditions allows a switch from the Hybrid model to more days of In-Person learning, the In-Person learning will be four days per week M,T,Th,F. (This does not apply to students that have chosen full virtual instruction.)
- Wednesday will remain dedicated to virtual services
- Monday, February 15, is Presidents Day NO SCHOOL: On this week Group A will receive instructional services on Tuesday (Feb 16) and Wednesday (Feb 17)
- Inclement weather days will be Virtual/Remote learning days for the remainder of the year
- ACT administered at HCHS on March 9. (**This day will be <u>Virtual/Remote</u>**<u>Learning for High School students NOT INVOLVED in ACT testing.</u> All other students Preschool-Eighth (8th) grades can still have in-person learning on that day.)
- Picture Day at HCHS is March 12
- Spring Break is April 5 9 (NO SCHOOL)
- Last Student Day May 18
- Prom tentatively scheduled outdoors for May 8
- Graduation is scheduled outdoors for May 21 with makeup on May 22
- Summer Academy will offer two sessions, 4 days per week (T,W,Th,F) Students/families may choose from either session
- Session I June 1 25 or Session II July 6 30
- 2021-22 School Year Opening Day for Staff August 10
- 2021-22 School Year 1st Day for Students August 12
