

## LAKELAND REGIONAL HIGH SCHOOL INDOOR SPECTATOR POLICY 2021

With the recent announcement by Governor Murphy and NJSIAA to allow for limited in-person spectator attendance at high school athletic contests, the Lakeland Regional High School District will now permit spectators at our indoor athletic events under the following guidelines:

1. As recommended by the NJSIAA, only a maximum of 2 parents/guardians will be permitted per athlete for each athlete participating in an event.
2. *Only parents/guardians of Lakeland athletes will be permitted to attend on-site indoor events.* The parents/spectators of opposing schools are not permitted on site but will be able to view all Lakeland events which will be livestreamed either on the N.F.H.S. Network or Lakeland T.V. Lakeland athlete's siblings or other family members, and community members, will have access to livestreaming as well.
3. Any parent/guardian entering our site must wear a mask - that covers both mouth and nose - at all times.
4. Parents/guardians must check in before each game at a table nearest the parking lot entrance of the East Gym, and the vestibule of the West Gym, where temperatures will be taken. This table will include hand sanitizer and signage reminding all to wear masks and properly socially distance. A roster of each Lakeland team playing will be at the table and parents will be signed in. Only parents/guardians of the athlete will be permitted to attend. Each parent/guardian will also fill out the daily COVID -19 questionnaire and will only be permitted to enter if no symptoms are documented. A Lakeland staff member will oversee the check in process. Spectators are encouraged to please use restrooms prior to entering the building but bathrooms nearest each check in area will be available. Bathrooms will be monitored by the evening maintenance staff.
5. Parents/guardians will only be admitted for their child's event and must leave immediately at the conclusion of this event. They will be seated on the opposite side of the gym - away from players. In the case of a doubleheader event (jv basketball followed by varsity), varsity parents will not be allowed to enter the gym until the JV game has concluded and the bleachers are cleared. Varsity parents will enter and exit the West Gym using the hallway entrance closest to

the Nurse's Office. JV parents after check in, will enter directly into the West Gym via the Team Room and Braille Room entrance.

Spectators for the second game will be seated opposite the player benches but in the section of bleachers that was unoccupied during the first game. This will prevent the need to spray bleachers between games and both sets of bleachers will be sprayed by the maintenance staff at the conclusion of the doubleheader.

6. When seated in the gym, spectators will be directed to sit by the "Xs" that are distanced throughout the bleachers. A minimum of 6 feet is expected between spectators. Masks may not be removed at any time and food and drink is not permitted.

Spectators will be expected to clear the gym immediately at the conclusion of the game and must continue to wear a mask while on school property.

7. The Lakeland Regional High School District reserves the right to immediately eject any spectator who is not in full compliance at all times.
