



GARRETTSVILLE WAS HOME TO RECORD SETTING RED OAK

GARRETTSVILLE – Most people who have grown up in the Garrettsville area know that the Lifesaver was invented here. We were known for producing the most maple syrup in the world and the great train robbery of 1935, but few people are aware that Garrettsville had the largest Red Oak tree in the World. Yes, the world!

The tree was located on Water Street and owned by Richard Lawless. It reigned as the largest Red Oak in the Nation for some time, finally being dethroned by a tree in New York state in 1987. At the time it was the biggest Red Oak in the world. The largest Red Oak in the world today is supposed to be in Russia. Currently there are co-champion Red Oaks nationally, one tree in Virginia and one in Ashtabula. Both have scored just a few points higher than the massive Oak of Garrettsville. The tree was roughly 8 ½ feet in diameter, 90 feet tall, and had a crown spread of over 90 feet as well. The fact that this tree grew to this size at all is truly amazing in itself.

In Ohio, prior the first settlement in Marietta, 95 % of Ohio was covered by forest. Maple, Beech, Ash dominated northeast while Oaks and Hickories were more pervasive everywhere else. By 1910, there was only 10% of forest cover left



in Ohio. Now it is estimated that around 35% of the state has forest cover. However, Ohio has very few if any virgin trees remaining. That is what made this tree so special. It was one of the last virgin trees not cut down as Ohio was settled in the 1800's and early 1900's.




Sadly, the tree, due to age and decay had to be cut down years ago, and up until this past April, the massive stump remained.

In September of 1940, American Forests (then The American Forestry Association) launched a campaign to locate the largest living specimens of American trees. The National Register of Champion Trees started out as a competition, a national hunt to discover and preserve the largest specimens of American tree species. The campaign to find America's largest trees grew from a desire to protect and preserve them for future generations. The trees people hunted for were scattered through forest and field, along roadways, and in backyards. There are specific criteria involved in determining if a tree qualifies as a potential champion. It is based on a point system and factors such as circumference, height, and crown spread are measured. These measurements are then added together to get a total point value. The highest point total is crowned champion. The tree in Garrettsville earned 440 points. The current co-champions have earned 446 and 556 points respectively. Ohio is currently home to fourteen species of national champion trees. The Ohio Department of Natural Resources has a link on its web site which list all the state champion species and the county they are located. Another local connection to big trees is Davy Tree, located in Kent. Davy has been a sponsor of the national big tree program for the past twenty-five years.

If you want to want to see some big trees, one must visit Congaree National Park in South Carolina. Within the park they have six national champions and 25 state champions. It is quite a place if you like big trees!





GARRETTSVILLE REOPENS AMIDST ONGOING PANDEMIC

GARRETTSVILLE – If necessity is the mother of invention, then we're entering into an accelerated Age of Innovation. As local storefronts and services reopen to the public amidst an ongoing pandemic, they are devising new ways to keep employees and patrons safe while getting back to business.

While state and federal officials provide specific reopening protocols for salons, barbershops, restaurants and medical offices, many remaining retail businesses and service entities must work out their own approach as they emerge from lockdown.

Each reopening is customized to best suit clientele's interests and each business's ability to operate within a

wide array of medical, financial and practical unknowns. As Jonathan Harris, Director of Portage County District Library (PCDL) put it, "It's not every day that you get to reinvent library services for the community."

GARRETTSVILLE LIBRARY

Speaking of the library, June 1 marked its first day of "contactless curbside pickup" in Stage II in its phased approach to PCDL's return-to-service plan. Two weeks prior, it had instituted Stage I, consisting of restocking Library Express pickup lockers with books in Mantua and Hiram.

During this Stage II phase, patrons can call ahead at 330-527-4378 or place holds online (portagelibrary. org) to reserve books, DVDs, audiobooks, CDs, etc. Staff members are back at work full-time and can answer questions, provide recommendations and otherwise provide reader advisory services by phone according to previous hours of operation (10am-8pm M-W, 10am-6pm F, 9am-5pm Sat).

Reserved library items will be placed in a paper bag labeled with the patron's name and can be picked up from a table in the front lobby for a period of three weeks (extended from the usual two-week borrowing period).

Anyone who has been holding on to borrowed library materials since the statewide shutdown should feel free to return these items to the library. No late fees will be

charged, Harris said. At this point, all returned items are being placed in isolation for 72 hours, according to CDC guidelines. No further sanitation steps are being taken at this time but could change, pending evolving recommendations.

Meanwhile, no programming has been scheduled at the local library and there is no target date set yet for Stage III, when doors will reopen for people to browse the shelves, share computer usage or otherwise interact inside the library building. When these services resume, Harris said that new health protocols will be in place, including protective barriers, one-way aisles of foot traffic, face masks and hand sanitizer.

While workers are required to wear face masks, guidelines for patrons are still under discussion by library administration, Harris indicated. According to his point of view, based on best practices for public health, "Patrons can pick up holds without wearing a mask but if they want to enter the library and interact in shared spaces, they should wear a mask."

VILLAGE BOOKSTORE

Heading to Main Street, Ellen Eckhouse's Village Bookstore is also partially reopened. While her doors are closed to casual browsing throughout the used book store, Eckhouse is in the shop every day but Monday, providing takeout/delivery services.

Similar to the library service plan, customers can call 330-527-3010 or send a private message

through the Village Bookstore Facebook page or website to pre-order a book. This mode of operation has been in place since April.

"I would love to throw open my doors now and welcome people in to shop the shelves, but this may not be the right time for us and our customers to be safe under those conditions," Eckhouse said. "Since I can't spray my books with Lysol without damaging them, I am willing to work hard to streamline options for customers with takeout, delivery, recommendations, Zoom book club meetings and maybe even private shopping by appointment."

She also is offering \$1 books and book genre mystery bags out on a bench in front of the store. Until there are clear procedural guidelines or a vaccine in place, Eckhouse says the bookstore will continue to improvise and operate as safely as possible.

CHARLES AUTO

After closing down the car dealership for the entire month of April and providing just emergency service



and appointment-only sales, Bruce Abraham partially reopened Charles Auto Family on May 4. After using the shutdown period to regroup and determine best practices going forward, all staff members came back to work full-time as of June 2. Business has been so brisk, Abraham says he may be hiring additional talent soon.

One month after reopening, Abraham reported, "We've had one of our better months for a long, long time; due to pent-up demand and a great staff working real hard to follow all the sanitation and social distancing guidelines and updating our online options. Our disinfecting and social distancing protocols make people more comfortable doing business with us. We disinfect every car before and after service and test drives. We disinfect door handles and bathrooms regularly throughout the day. Most of us don't like wearing masks but we can put up with it to keep everyone safe."

Recognizing that 'the new normal' is a moving target, Abraham said that he and his staff had to construct a way forward during this ongoing pandemic. "In order to be successful, I need to respond to my customers and their needs. People are afraid of the unknown so we're doing our best to provide a safe pathway through it. Today's environment dictates what's right."




EAGLE CREEK

Streams, creeks and rivers are often called the "lifeblood" of our planet. Rightly so, there is no denying water is essential for the biological aspect of our lives and the lives of all living things that share this world; even so it attends the varying other needs of our existence, often in a more intangible manifestation.


Since humankind has existed, establishing communities in proximity to water has been a necessity and typically fundamental to success. The peoples who lived near and eventually settled this area no less followed that instinctual drive to congregate near a convenient and seemingly renewable source of fresh water when they happened upon Eagle Creek.

Prior to and during European settlement, Native American tribes such as the Seneca led by Chief Big Son undoubtedly frequented the creek during travels between their villages near present day



Streetsboro and around Nelson Ledges State Park. By the time settlers of the Western Reserve, such as John Garrett, arrived at Eagle Creek, which flows through the heart of our village, then known as Silver Creek, met those basic and fundamental needs, providing fresh, clean water for everyday

use and, with the help of gravity, energy to power the local grist mill.

The name of the creek likely changed around the mid-20th century when stream names were ascribed to the overall length of the watercourse and the size of its watershed; maps from the mid-19th century label it as Silver Creek, Eagle Creek and even the Mahoning River. One cannot even guess what the native peoples called it, as they rarely named geographical features at all. Regardless, while the need for harnessing the creek's energy was a prime mover for early settlers of Garrettsville, there is little doubt that the innate beauty and soothing quality of water in motion was no less admired than it is today.

While the grindstones of the mill may be silent, the roar of rushing water onto the rocks below can power the spirit for those searching for something to relieve the stresses of everyday life. Eagle Creek's headwaters begin approximately

six miles northwest of the village, just south of the intersection of Alpha and Wakefield Roads in the form of small inconspicuous wetlands, at present buffered and protected by deciduous forests.

Meandering south and east, this tiny almost





imperceptible movement of water gains strength from numerous seeps, springs and other small streams. Black Creek to the south and Silver Creek to the north bolster the flow as it winds its way through bottom lands and marshes, meeting with the main branch in secluded woodland settings.





Relatively secret and majestic landmarks such as "Forty-foot Falls", perhaps inspiration for "The Bridge" written by Garrettsville native and poet Hart Crane, flank the creek valley including several beautiful outcroppings of Sharon Conglomerate sandstone standing sentinel over its march.

For thousands of years following the last continental ice age, the waters of Eagle Creek have steadily flowed past Native American encampments, through our back yards, woodlots and farm fields almost unencumbered save by fallen timbers or the occasional beaver dam until reaching Garrettsville. Slowed to nearly a stop by the arch dam above the falls, the landscape hidden beneath these waters is undoubtedly one which few if anyone alive today have truly gazed upon, a scene that perhaps one day will be revealed. As many dams are being removed around the region due to safety risks, lack of necessity, costly repairs and to reestablish ecological services, communities may be pleasantly surprised to witness an even more beautiful view, one seen by our native peoples and early settlers.

Presently however, the experience which Eagle Creek affords both visitors and local community members in undiminished. Behind the brick and wood facades of Main Street a secret place awaits sojourners and residents alike, seeking a place to reflect and find respite. Atop the boardwalk spanning the creek one is afforded a magnificent view of the cataracts below as they cascade onto the sandstone bedrock, terminating into swirling pools and eddies that harbor many aquatic

creatures.. and the occasional blue heron.

Fish such as fantail darters, western black-nose dace and golden redhorse find refuge in the pools and riffles from the hunting eyes of birds like the kingfisher or the stoic blue heron. Tree swallows dart and dive low over the water in an aerial pursuit of emerging mayflies and stoneflies. An observant onlooker might catch a glimpse of a mink seeking out frogs and crayfish, scurrying about the crevices of high-walled ledges wreathed in the verdant colors of lichens, mosses and ferns. A chance encounter with an otter or two bobbing about in their playful fashion on the hunt for mussels buried in the silty deposits of the creek bed is not an impossibility either.


And while for the observer it may seem as though the story of Eagle Creek ends in this picturesque image within the confines of a beautiful country town, its journey has barely begun.

Less than a mile further downstream its waters join Camp Creek before entering the Eagle Creek State Nature Preserve. Comprised of 483 acres, many different habitats are preserved and accessible via four miles of hiking trails, home to throngs of living creatures and one of the best spring wildflower display in our state.

For another ten- and one-half miles it continues gradually southeast less observed by human eyes until its eventual confluence with the Mahoning River. Yet it is within the surrounding villages such as Garrettsville, that the source for the continued beauty and sustainability of Eagle Creek resides.
