Chairman Scully called the meeting to order. The pledge to the flag was recited.

## **Approval of Minutes**

Minutes for the regular June 10<sup>th</sup> meeting were submitted for approval. Trustee George made the motion to approve the minutes as amended. Trustee Clark seconded the motion. Trustee Frye abstained as she was not present at the meeting. The remaining trustees present voted their approval.

## **PUBLIC COMMENT**

Jim Frey

Mr. Frey addressed the board regarding the physical education curriculum. He and his wife

are concerned that the main focus is playing dodge ball. They would like to see the curriculum expanded to include other activities, such as, Tai Chi or something along those lines.

## Becky Vujovich

Ms. Vujovich reported to the board she has applied for a grant for \$5,000 to help with the cost of installing a sidewalk from Chowning to First Street. It requires a match that she already funded. She will know by December if they are awarded the grant.

## Chris McCown

Mr. McCown presented information to the board about the Fishing in Schools Program. He said this program is used in the middle and high school physical education classes. The students learn how to fish and learn about fish and their habitat. The program also utilizes other subjects, such as, language arts, science and technology. The program gets students outdoors and teaches them a life long skill. He approached the students last year to see what kind of interest there would be and had eighteen students interested with most of them female. Mr. McCown visited with Mr. Fredrickson and Ms. Schilling about adding this program to their curriculum and they were receptive. A representative from the program would train the instructors and get them certified. He thought the cost would be approximately \$3,400 and would clarify to see what this cost covers. He said the district could apply for a grant and he was willing to write the grant. Mr. Hilton said this was the same way we brought Archery into the school. Trustee George felt this was very viable and the district should also look at local support.

## **COMMUNICATIONS AND PETITIONS**

## Principals' Reports Mr. Hilton's Report

Mr. Hilton said the school is looking great and the maintenance staff had worked very hard this summer. The summer crew has also done a great job this summer. Currently, K-8 enrollment is at 228 students. We have one new staff member, Emily Willmuth. She has been in working in her classroom and has a great work ethic. Mr. Hilton said the theme for the first day of school will be Hollywood. Junior high athletes start Aug 26<sup>th</sup> and there will be a substitute teacher meeting on Aug 27<sup>th</sup>. The kindergarten students will begin September 3<sup>rd</sup>. The kindergarten teachers will meet with parents prior to the students beginning class. Mr. Hilton said summer went by quickly, but he has been impressed with the time the teachers have spent on professional development. Trustee George asked if

the district has reached out to home school families and families that have left the district? Mr. Sullivan explained some home school students come in for a class or two and he tries to encourage them to participate in more courses. Trustee Clark said he has talked to home school parents and he doesn't think we can change their minds. Superintendent Overstreet explained the district sends out information to parents about federal programs the home school student can participate in and we have not had anyone interested. He has asked them to try part-time for the social aspect. He said we can get a list from Melinda Legg and contact the parents.

## Mr. Sullivan's Report

Mr. Sullivan presented the results from the CRT testing. He explained the district contracts with Ken Stuker and he puts together the report. The principals break the report down further and discuss results with their staff. Mr. Sullivan explained the district scores are above the state in reading and have steadily improved. The math scores for the most part are above the state average and are improving at a slower pace. He explained our science scores are the lowest but are still above state average. He said we have been increasing scores since this was but in place in 2004 and the state is required to have all students 100% proficient by 2014. This year 60% of the schools in Montana failed. Mr. Hilton said the test may change in the future once the common core standards are in place. Trustee George asked if the reading scores increased more because the standard changed? Mr. Hilton felt the biggest factor was that effort has improved. Chairman Scully asked if there were any ACT and SAT comparisons? Mr. Sullivan said he will put this information together for him. He said in the past only four students have taken the test and they are usually the top students so the average was high. Last year the state allowed all Juniors to take the test at no cost so the average may be lower this year.

Mr. Sullivan reported enrollment is up to 105 students. Fall sports will begin August 19<sup>th</sup> with approximately fitty-three students participating. He said in September he will ask the board for approval for two or three students to graduate early. He explained the students have the option to participate in the graduation ceremonies. They also have the opportunity to be valedictorian or salutatorian and can receive scholarships. Trustee Frye asked what the students have planned? Chairman Scully said at some point there needed to be some discussion about curriculum. He talked to students at career day and some say they want to get out of here because they are tired of doing nothing. He asked if online courses were making it easier for students to graduate early? Mr. Sullivan said Ennis requires twenty-five credits which is more than Bozeman. He said we seldom have students graduate early and the students who want to graduate early have plans in January to go to college. Mr. Sullivan also felt the building was in great shape.

## Superintendent's Report

## **Summer Projects Report**

Superintendent Overstreet explained the computer upgrade is almost complete, the chain link fence and gate has been completed, new counters in the FCS room are finished, the gym floors have been waxed and the storage room for the school play supplies has been completed. He said Brand McBride has done a great job on the storage room. Some projects still being completed are the roof drains, carpet in the high school, football scoreboard, new heaters in the elementary gym and a sign for the elementary school. Trustee George asked about the bid for the roof on the rental house. Superintendent Overstreet explained once the siding project began they discovered the roof needed to be replaced. He said when he bid the siding project there weren't any responses and he had to ask contractors for bids. Since MDM was already working on the house he asked them to bid the roof. The bid includes top of the line shingles with a lifetime warranty.

## **School Begins**

Superintendent Overstreet presented the schedule for the beginning of the school year. Teachers return August 26<sup>th</sup> and students begin August 28<sup>th</sup>.

## Superintendent Goals

The board discussed Superintendent Overstreet's goals for the 2013-2014 school year. Superintendent Overstreet felt he has more work to do to restore community trust and he would like to address time on task, which would cut down on teacher and student absences. He asked the board if they still wanted him to transition his successor. Trustee George asked how he planned to restore community trust? Superintendent Overstreet said he planned to continue the budget committee, encourage people to attend board meetings, visit organizations and write articles for the paper. Chairman Scully didn't feel naming a successor should be a goal. He felt both principals should be trained because human relations, budgeting, leadership and common core will benefit both of them in their positions. Superintendent Overstreet was not confident that either one of them were interested in the position and they shouldn't feel obligated. Mr. Sullivan said the board paid for two of his classes and he is working on his degree. Mr. Hilton felt he was in a different stage in his career.

## **OLD BUSINESS**

## Report from Committee on Sidewalk Project

Superintendent Overstreet explained the committee met and determined it was best to wait on this project. If they tied the Golf Course Connection, the parking lot and the sidewalk project together, the district could save on expenses. Trustee George felt the district

should look at closing or at least limiting the parking on the north side of the school due to liability issues. The board discussed the barrier, cleaning out the dead trees and adding grass on the corner of Chowning. Superintendent Overstreet will meet this the engineer to discuss the additional requests and costs. Becky Vujovich said the Lowes' grant has been set aside for the school section of this project.

## Sick/Vacation Payout for Doug Walsh

Superintendent Overstreet received information from Elizabeth Kaleva and an attorney from MTSBA in regards to the payout for Doug Walsh. They both felt he was entitled to the compensation, but the vacation pay would only be for forty-eight days. If the district did not pay they could face a wage claim and be forced to pay four times the amount and attorney fees.

Trustee George said Mr. Walsh negotiated his settlement with TRS and it was not a ruling. He said Mr. Walsh through the entire process claimed to be a 1/3 time superintendent and stated so in depositions and signed contracts. He would actually owe the district money under these circumstances. Now he is turning around and asking for full-time compensation. The district paid \$92,000 for his contributions to TRS and we should go after him for that. Are we going to have other issues down the road, possibly OPI?

Trustee Lake said this is a wage claim, which is different.

Trustee Frye agreed with Trustee George. She said board members also stated in depositions that Mr. Walsh was a part-time superintendent. She said we need to stop the bleeding.

Chairman Scully explained the district paid the \$92,000 because we were obligated to collect the TRS contribution from Mr. Walsh when he was under our employment. He did not feel the district would survive a wage claim. He also felt the release should have covered this, but TRS would not get involved with a wage claim release. Chairman Scully did feel Mr. Walsh was now claiming full-time because he lost the TRS settlement. He also felt the past board members were in collusion. Chairman Scully did not want to pay the compensation but felt it was in the best interest of the district to pay.

Trustee Clark said we couldn't do anything now except pay.

Trustee Lake asked if Mr. Walsh would sign a release for any and all future wage claims against the district? She said it would need to be worded correctly to protect the district.

Superintendent Overstreet said the release with TRS did not cover wage claims, but the district did collect approximately \$16,000 for contributions paid to MPERA on Mr. Walsh's behalf. He said Mr. Walsh's attorney was waiting to hear from the board.

Trustee Lake made a motion to approve the payment of sick/vacation leave to Doug Walsh to include forty-eight vacation days and one-quarter of the accumulated sick leave providing Doug Walsh signs a release waiver to fully release and indemnify the district, prepared for the benefit of the district for any and all future claims of any nature including wage claims against the district to be approved by the board. The cost of the payment would be \$33,013.92. Trustee Clark seconded the motion. All trustees present were in approval.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

## Approve Coaching Hires: Nick Burgess and Glen Charon

Superintendent Overstreet informed the board Pokey Armitage resigned his position due to a business opportunity. He recommended Nick Burgess for the head girls' basketball position. He has three years experience as the assistant coach. Superintendent Overstreet opened the position to the entire staff and no one else was interested. The assistant football coach position was open when Jack Mueller left the district. Brian Lovett moved to this position which left a junior high position open. Glen Charon and Matt Ritter were interested in the position. The football coaches met with Paul Bills and they would like to see Glen Charon in the junior high position.

Trustee George asked if there was anyone for the assistant basketball coach? Superintendent Overstreet said they interviewed three candidates, Muriel Boyd, Kelly Knack and Caitlin Hart. All three were qualified and they offered the position to Ms. Boyd. This will be on the agenda for September.

Chairman Scully asked who Mr. Charon would report to? He has seen him at football games and was concerned that although he was enthusiastic, he may not be a good role model for the kids. The administration will need to pay close attention to him.

Trustee Frye said Mr. Charon's behavior also extended to other activities, not just football.

Superintendent Overstreet said he can go overboard and he felt most of his comments were positive, except maybe, to officials. He said their concerns will be addressed with Mr. Charon.

Trustee George made a motion to approve the coaches as presented. Trustee Clark seconded the motion. All trustees present were in approval.

## Set Board Goals for 2013-2014 School Year

The board felt this should be addressed with more time during a special meeting. They felt common core curriculum and security should be added to the goals.

## **Discuss Investments on CDARS**

Ms. Martello informed the board our investments mature in September. She said since the agreement with the county to run the district's finances through First Interstate Bank ends June 30, 2104, we would only want to invest the money for six months. The rates for six month CDARS are only .01%. If we put the money in the repurchase account it will gain .05%. The board asked if it was feasible to move the money now to the county since the investments are due. Ms. Martello explained it is not recommended to change financial institutions in the middle of a year and our agreement ends June 30<sup>th</sup>. She said the previous board moved the money from the county because STIP was invested in subprime mortgages which are very risky. They were also going to limit how much money could be withdrawn from STIP at the time the district was going to begin construction. Ms. Martello informed the board STIP is currently returning at .18%. Chairman Scully said there are still concerns with STIP. Trustee Clark made a motion to move the money that matures from the CDARS in September to the repurchase account. Trustee Frye seconded the motion. All trustees present were in approval.

## Review Trustees' Financial Summary Report

Ms. Martello presented the Annual Trustees' Financial Summary Report for review. Superintendent Overstreet explained this is an overview of the district's finances for the year. Ms. Martello explained the fixed asset portion was not correct and she was working with the auditor on this section.

## **Approve Final Budget**

Superintendent Overstreet informed the board we have a 1% increase to the general fund. Transportation is lowered as far as we are able without losing state and county funding. This fund spends around \$500,000 per year, therefore, we can go one more year without milling in this fund. Bus depreciation will not need any mills either. The district can purchase an activity bus out of this fund if needed. The retirement fund has increased and is funded through the county. Superintendent Overstreet said the board asked about reserves in the adult education budget, therefore, he budgeted \$600,000 in reserves. This would leave enough to cover the program for a couple of years if money was transferred by voter approval from the adult education fund. The building reserve fund has a couple of levies left which will leave \$838,000 in the fund. There are several large projects to begin next spring that will be expended from the building reserve fund. The technology fund has a voted levy of \$36,000 per year. This year we will be under 20 total mills for all budgeted funds.

Trustee George was concerned with the transportation and adult education funds and their allocations.

Trustee Frye felt an allocation plan should be part of the documentation. She said the taxpayers need to know the board is being responsible.

Trustee Clark said the budget is the plan

Chairman Scully felt the building reserve may be too big and has been established without any declaration of its use. He asked how big this budget should be? He would like to look at adult education, transportation and the building reserve fund in more detail and would like the adult education resolved by January.

Superintendent Overstreet agreed the adult education program needed to be addressed. He explained this did not happen in one year and it would take time to fix. He did not feel the building reserve fund was out of line. The budget is not perfect, but it is balanced and lowered from last year.

Trustee Frye made a motion to approve the budget as presented. Trustee Clark seconded the motion. All members present were in approval.

## Approve Adult Education Classes/Instructors

The fall adult education classes and instructors were presented for approval. The board felt some of the things that needed to be addressed in this program includes, programs that were not adult education that have now become adult education courses, such as, community choir, fees don't come close to covering costs, adult education directors are teaching courses, no direction fiscally, as well as, many other concerns. The board agreed to approve the list as presented with the understanding this program will be reviewed by January. Trustee George made a motion to approve the adult education classes and instructors as presented. Trustee Clark seconded the motion. All trustees present were in favor. (See Attached)

## Approve RESA4U Co-op Agreement

Superintendent Overstreet asked the board for permission to join the RESA4U Co-op. He said the district will save money on items, such as, copy paper. This program was started with the Four Rivers chapter. Chairman Scully asked why the southwest co-op was better. Mr. Hilton felt the southwest would benefit the district better through professional development because it would limit travel distance. Trustee Clark made a motion to join the RESA4U Co-op. Trustee George seconded the motion. All members present were in favor.

## **Discuss Rental Fund**

Superintendent Overstreet informed the board he would like to put some guidelines in place regarding the district's rental properties. Ms. Martello said she spoke with Steve Hamel from OPI and he said the board can deposit rental money in another fund so we don't go over the \$20,000 cap. The board asked if we had that in writing. Superintendent Overstreet said having rentals are great for the district and he understood there were concerns about how they were purchased. He said the board could sell them and put the

money back in adult education. The board felt this should be addressed further and they needed to decide if they wanted to be in the rental business.

## **CLAIMS**

The June and July activity claims were presented for approval by the board. Trustee Frye made a motion to approve the checks as presented. Trustee Clark seconded the motion. All trustees present were in approval. The June and July warrant listing as well as the preliminary Aug claims listing were presented by fund for board approval. Trustee Clark made a motion to approve the checks as presented. Trustee George seconded the motion. All trustees present were in approval.

The next regular meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, September 11, 2013 at 5:00 p.m.

As there was no other business for the attention of the board, the regular meeting was adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
