Following a successful 36-year career at Greenville CSD, Superintendent Tammy Sutherland will be retiring after leading the district for six years.

The new superintendent will take office on or about February 1, 2022. The Board of Education plans to offer a 3-year contract with a hiring salary range of \$165,000–\$185,000 depending upon the qualifications, experience and record of the successful candidate. Residency close to the district is preferred to allow for active participation in school and community events.


