TRANSPORTATION

If a child does not ride the bus for a period of 14 days or more, the Transportation Department will reach out to the family to see if transportation is still needed.

You can opt-in to bus transportation any time during the year if your needs change.

Bus route assignments will be made within 48 hours of the request.

We encourage families not to request transportation if it's not needed. Accuracy is important so we can plan routes accordingly.

Route 4 - Medway/Earlton

- Buses will leave **PROMPTLY@ 4:15pm.**
- Students will require a bus pass signed by teacher/staff to board.
- If the student's residence or crossroad is along the route, they will be dropped off accordingly. Otherwise, students will be dropped off only @ **Drop** stops.
- Times are approximate dependent on ridership so please be waiting if you are picking your child up.
- **Route deviations are NOT permitted.**
- **Late buses will run Tuesday-Thursday**



BUS ROUTE CHANGES

Bus routes may not be based upon the "personal challenges facing individual parents" according to NYS Education Law. While all requests will be reviewed and investigated, stops cannot be changed for these reasons.

If you plan to request an alternate location for your child, please take notice of the following:

- Request forms must be submitted annually by August 1st or as soon as possible if family circumstances change during the school year. No changes will be implemented from August 26 through the second Monday of September.
- The request must be renewed every school year and/or whenever there is a change in arrangements.
