#### 2018 Race For Education Stats

- Over 22, 000 mailers were sent out to friends & family
- 960 students sent in at least 5 address labels & got to write their name on the Wall of Fame
- 850 students submitted at least 10 addresses or more & received a Stuffed Animal Day Card (GAPS) or PJ/Hat Day (GAES)
- This fall 728 students will get the opportunity to Eat lunch with their teacher because they brought in 15 or more labels.
- On Oct. 19th Over 560 students were awarded the chance to be apart of the high school football game halftime celebration/recognition because they submitted 20 labels or more.
- 450 students filled out the entire label sheet & their names were submitted into a drawing for the chance to play *Plinko* during our awards assembly on Nov. 2.
   All students who earned this prize received a free ice cream coupon.
- 340 students helped out the Race for Education by donating postage to our postage drive. They Submitted enough to mail 6,000 of our mailers for Free!
- On Oct 12th over **1400 students** were part of our 2018 Race Day!
- This year we have received over \$100,000 for our school because of YOU!
