Your child may not return to school until fever free for 24 hours (less than 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit, oral) without the use of antipyretics such as Tylenol (Acetaminophen), Advil/Motrin (Ibuprofen), etc. (It is not recommended to give children or teenagers Aspirin because it can cause Reyes Syndrome, a life-threatening illness).

If your child has vomiting or diarrhea, they will need to stay home until they are free of these problems for 24 hours.

If your child is taking/using antibiotics for strep throat, pink eye, impetigo, staph infections or other bacterial infections, etc., they need to stay home until they have been taking/using the antibiotic for 24 hours.

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If your child is sent home for a fever or any other signs and symptoms of the flu or COVID-19, we strongly advise taking your child to the doctor.

Signs & Symptoms of the Flu:

Fever, Cough, Sore throat, Runny or stuffy nose, Body aches, Headache, Chills, and Fatigue. Some people may have vomiting and diarrhea. Severe illnesses and death have occurred as a result of this virus.

Signs & Symptoms of COVID-19:

Temperature of 100.4 or higher, Sore throat, New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing, Diarrhea, Vomiting, Abdominal pain, Severe headache- especially with a fever.
