Good afternoon Bulldog Families,

This afternoon the Champaign Urbana Public Health District sent out communication that recommended that all school districts in Champaign County go to fully remote learning as soon as possible due to the rising number of COVID 19 cases in Champaign County. We are currently assessing this information and hope to learn more in a 4:00 p.m. press conference (today) where CUPHD and other officials will speak. This is an evolving situation, but I wanted you to be aware that this recommendation has been made. I will keep parents informed as we move ahead with any changes in plans for your child's education, including Kids Club. At this time, I ask that you not contact schools or Kids Club personnel until more is learned and known that will help us make decisions moving forward.

Thank you for your patience, again, this is a fluid situation right now as we ourselves learn more about this recommendation to Champaign County school districts.
