   These courses will appear in green and cannot be changed.
   (You may enter other requests/concerns in the "Special Request" box)
- Proceed in selecting elective and alternate courses
- Once completed, click save, print two copies (one for you & one for your meeting with your counselor)

#### Things to Know

- Core courses will be recommended by your current teachers
- When selecting courses:
  - 1) Please select a total of 8.0 credits for the year (7.0 credits if you are a LCTI student)
  - 2) In addition, please select 4 -6 alternative courses as you may have a conflict or not receive your primary requests. (LCTI no electives)
