PARENT/STUDENT RE-ENTRY ORIENTATION

Hybrid learning for the MS/HS will begin on March 1. To help families and students understand how this plan will work, the MS and HS are offering an orientation, both in-person and online:

- In-person orientation (third session)--February 24,2021@ 2:00 p.m. (MUST call the school and reserve a slot as no more than 10 will be allowed. Also, the inperson sessions are limited to one adult with their child(ren).)
- In-person orientation (fourth session)--February 24,2021@ 3:00 p.m. (MUST call the school and reserve a slot as no more than 10 will be allowed. Also, the in-person sessions are limited to one adult with their child(ren).)

ATHLETICS UPDATE

Scheduled sports start dates:

Fall: February 22- March 27
Winter: March 22-May 8
Spring: April 5- June 19

Details

- Only schools in full hybrid can compete.
- There is a 14 day calendar acclimation period from the start of hybrid to competition. (Spring Break does not count). Therefore, we had to opt out of Fall Sports.
- Peñasco MS/HS is scheduled to start Hybrid on March 1 start. This means that competition will begin on March 22 (due to Spring Break).

Competition/Games

- Athletes can choose to stay remote in a hybrid and still compete.
- Scheduling of games with non-district opponents will be within the region.
- As of right now no fans allowed for fall sports. We will be able to stream the games via the NFHS network.
- Athletes need to have physicals and concussion course completed before participating. Physicals and concussion course completion certificates need to be given to Athletic Coordinator Coach Mandy Montoya.
