S-OCS Stage 4 Plan All Schools (K-12) Remote Learning

Accessibility

The remote learning offered through S-OCS will be provided by the student's assigned teachers and students will work from home. Knowing that we have many families that do not have a reliable internet connection, the course work can be delivered in the offline component of a student's Chromebook, or on paper packets. Chromebooks will need to be connected to Wi-Fi weekly in order to upload and download assignments and lessons. Each school parking lot has available free Wi-Fi. Printed materials can be delivered weekly to the school or scanned and sent electronically.

- **K-2:** Students will be given learning packets on a weekly basis. Bins will be placed outside for families to drop off packets. Each building will distribute packets according to their building plan.
- 3-6: Students will take home their assigned Chromebook; students without internet access will receive packets on a weekly basis. Bins will be placed outside for families to drop off packets. Each building will distribute packets according to their building plan.
- 7-8: Students will take home their assigned Chromebook; students without internet access will receive packets weekly. Bins will be placed outside for families to drop off packets. Each building will distribute packets according to their building plan.
- 9-12: Students will take home their assigned Chromebook; students without internet access will need to download content weekly to complete on their Chromebook.

Schedule

Remote learning through S-OCS teachers will be tracked by weekly completion of work and activity. It is highly recommended that the student sticks to a daily routine for completion of the work so as not to get behind. Students will have some flexibility on what time of day they complete the work but must observe all deadlines set up by the teacher. Attendance will be taken via the PowerSchool Portal. To be marked present, students must complete the academic expectations as determined by their teacher(s).

Communication

S-OCS teachers will hold two one-hour sessions (one AM and one PM) of office hours for their students to join them live for questions or concerns. All S-OCS students and staff have the ability to email one another throughout the day. To find teacher email or phone number/extension, please visit the school's website. Every teacher has a webpage with their contact information, including email and phone extension. Teachers will/could also meet and communicate with students through asynchronous teaching.
